National Scholarship Application Guidelines

western fraternal life association recognizes the need for higher education and the increasing cost of obtaining this goal. The Association is pleased to establish this fraternal benefit to help our members grow into future leaders. At least ten National Scholarships will be awarded annually for up to \$1,000 to qualified members attending college or vocational programs.

Eligibility Requirements

- The applicant must be a **wfla** member in good standing for two (2) years prior to the application deadline.
- Individuals may apply each year for the scholarships, however, they are eligible to win only twice.
- Applicant must be accepted or attending as a full-time student at a College/University or Vocational/Technical Institution for an entire school year. A copy of the verification must be included.
- Recipients of other **wfla** scholarships, lodge, district or state, are eligible for the **wfla** National Scholarship.

Regulations

- **wfla** awards ten (10) scholarships annually up to \$1,000 each, limited to tuition and books.
- Scholarships are awarded on academic ability based on the appropriate test scores, school and community involvement, and financial need. Please submit the following records by **March 1**:
 1. Fully completed scholarship application form with essay attachment
 2. High school official transcripts
 3. SAT and/or ACT test scores
 4. Acceptance letter from a college/university or vocational/technical school, if currently not attending
 5. College/university or vocational/technical school official transcripts, if currently attending
- **Termination of membership in wfla** automatically terminates the scholarship.
- Scholarships are made directly to each student's school for tuition, books, and incidentals.
- **western fraternal life association** will not be responsible for the student's conduct, personal affairs or debts incurred while receiving scholarship funds.
- If a recipient's studies are interrupted by illness, accident, or other extenuating circumstances, he or she may request the scholarship be held for him or her during that time. Any such interruption must be reported promptly to the Fraternal Manager for action.
- **wfla screens applications for eligibility as a member in good standing for two years, but will not engage in making evaluations or selections. Information on candidates for these scholarships will be processed by an independent scholarship committee.**

The **wfla** National Scholarship is a NONCONTRACTUAL benefit, subject to change by the Board of Directors.

Award Process

- Selections are made by a committee from the educational/business community independent of **wfla**.
- All applications and other academic information must be received by **wfla** no later than **March 1**. The scholarships are announced in May and awarded in August for the school year beginning in August.
